

## Rotary Club of Bainbridge Island Community Grants: Examples of What We Fund

The Community Grants Program of the Rotary Club of Bainbridge Island funds capital items/assets/non-consumables. We define capital expenditures as tangible items/property with a prolonged useful life, substantially beyond one year.

We do not fund operational expenses. Please see the list of examples below of what we fund/don't fund.

Note: we also do not fund the purchase of land.

Examples of proposed capital expenditures we will consider funding:	Examples of operational expenditures we do not fund:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Technology, such as computers, including first-year software subscription</li> <li>• Furniture, appliances, cabinetry</li> <li>• Building supplies and labor to construct/remodel a structure/room/area</li> <li>• Installing a trail, walkway or artwork</li> <li>• Roofing, re-wiring, flooring, fencing, and permanent signage</li> <li>• Machinery and tools</li> <li>• Recreation and sports equipment/materials that are reusable year-to-year</li> <li>• Equipment/gear/instruments (reusable year-to-year)</li> <li>• Medical equipment and devices</li> <li>• Vehicles to support programs and services</li> <li>• Permits, tax and shipping related to purchases noted above</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ongoing software subscriptions</li> <li>• General program support</li> <li>• Single-use, disposable items, including office supplies</li> <li>• Rent</li> <li>• Marketing</li> <li>• Payroll</li> <li>• Training and travel costs</li> <li>• Fundraising event costs</li> </ul>
